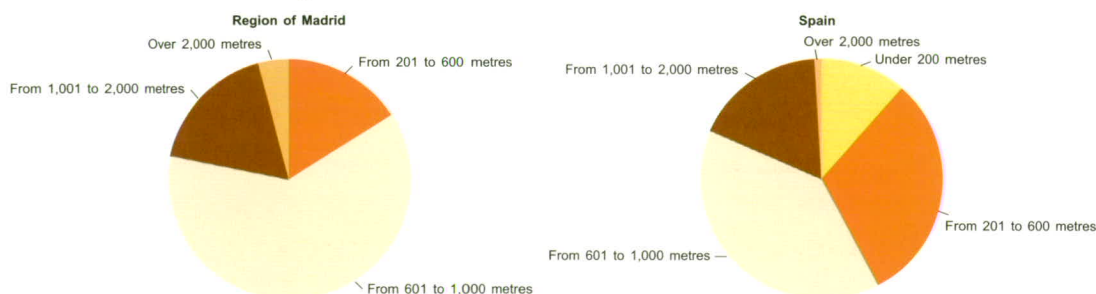

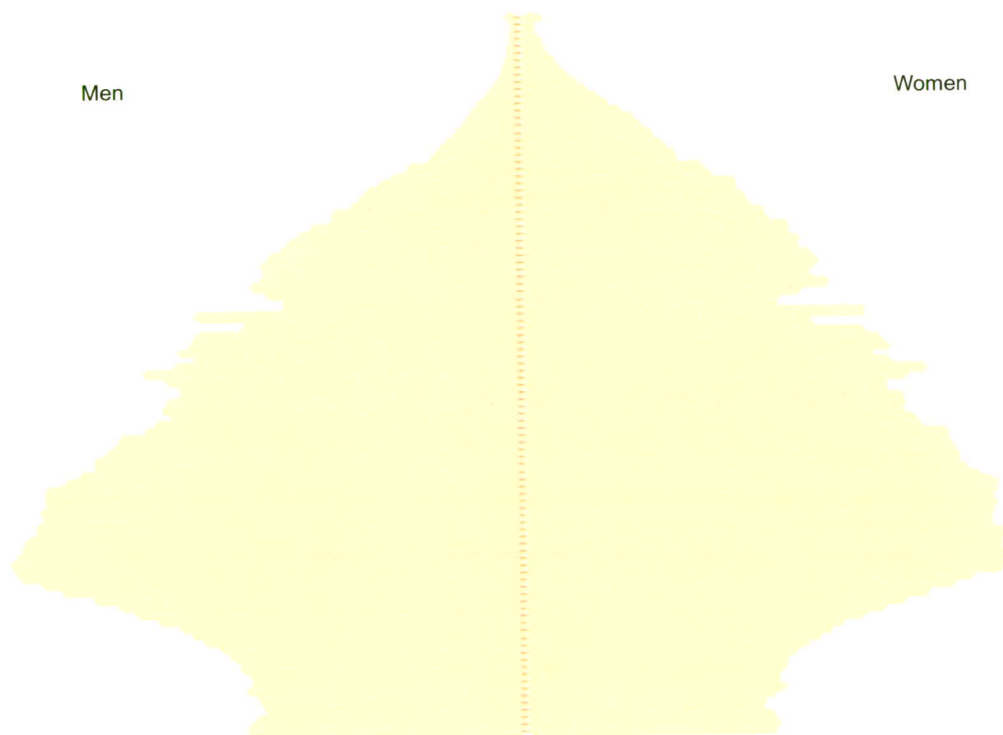

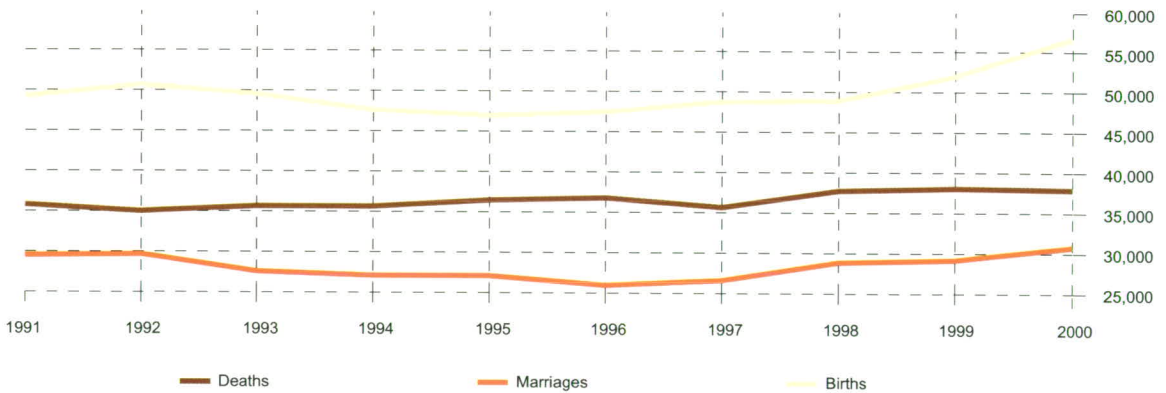

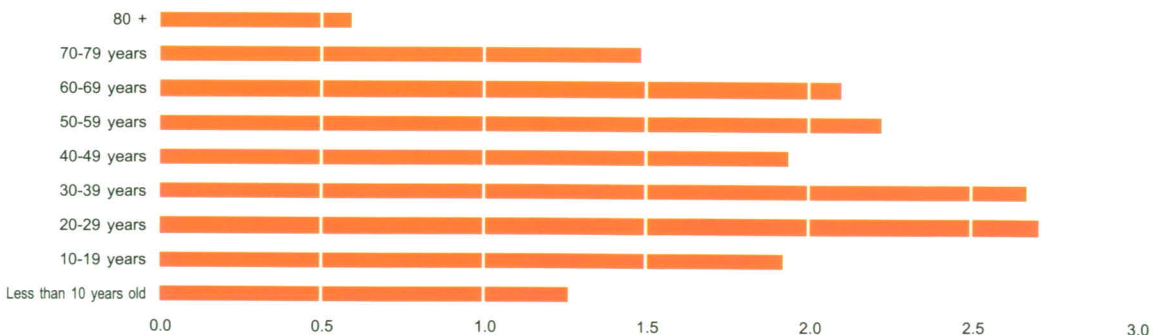

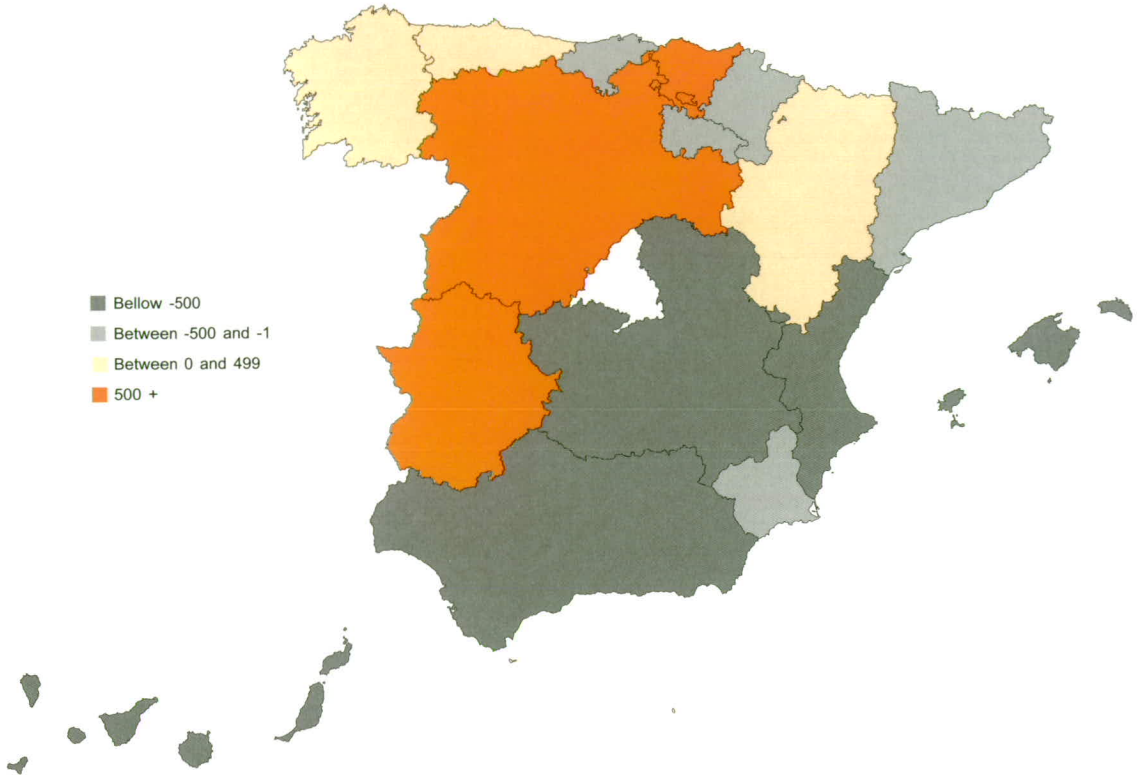
2.4. Year-to-year changes in births, deaths, and marriages

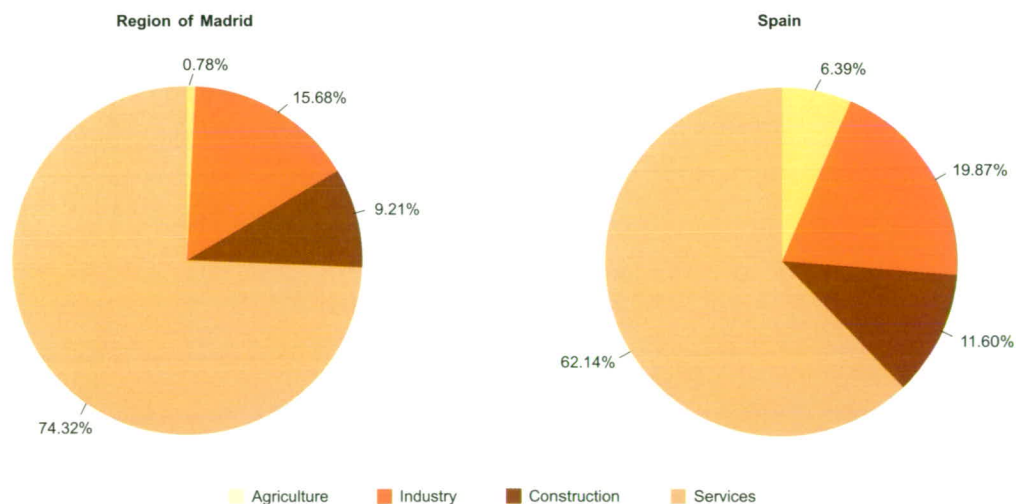

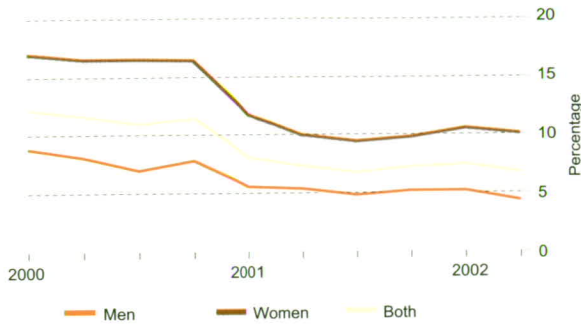

3.2. Breakdown of employment by sectors. 2001

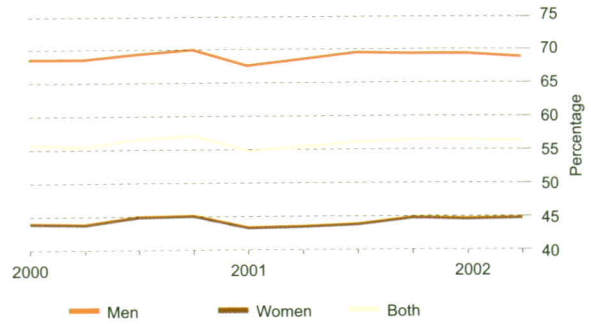


3.3. EPA*: year-to-year change in unemployment rate by sex

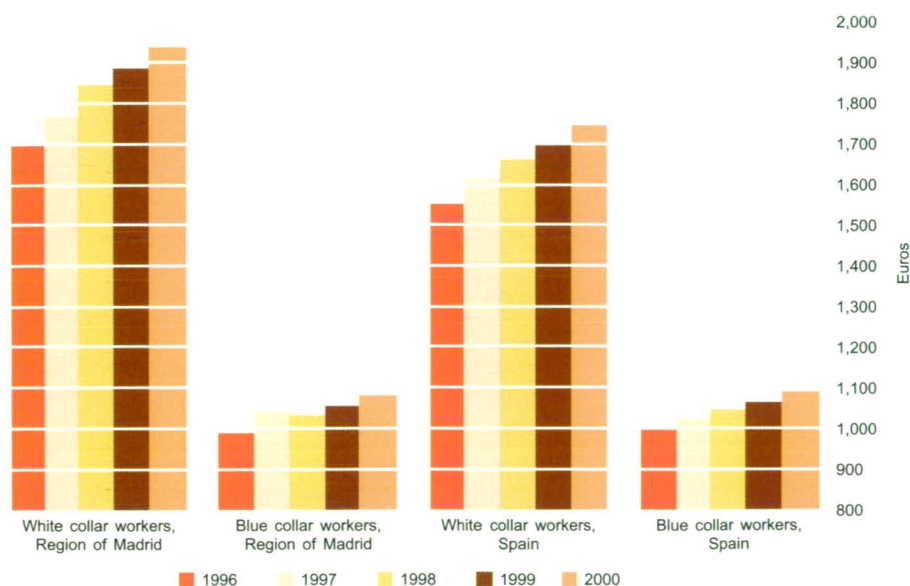

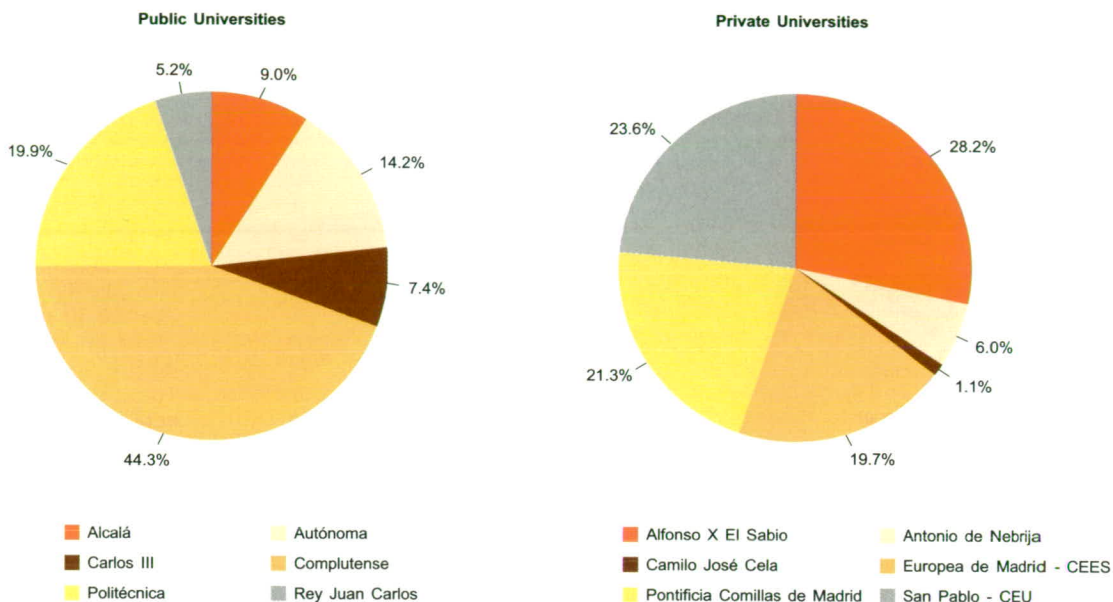

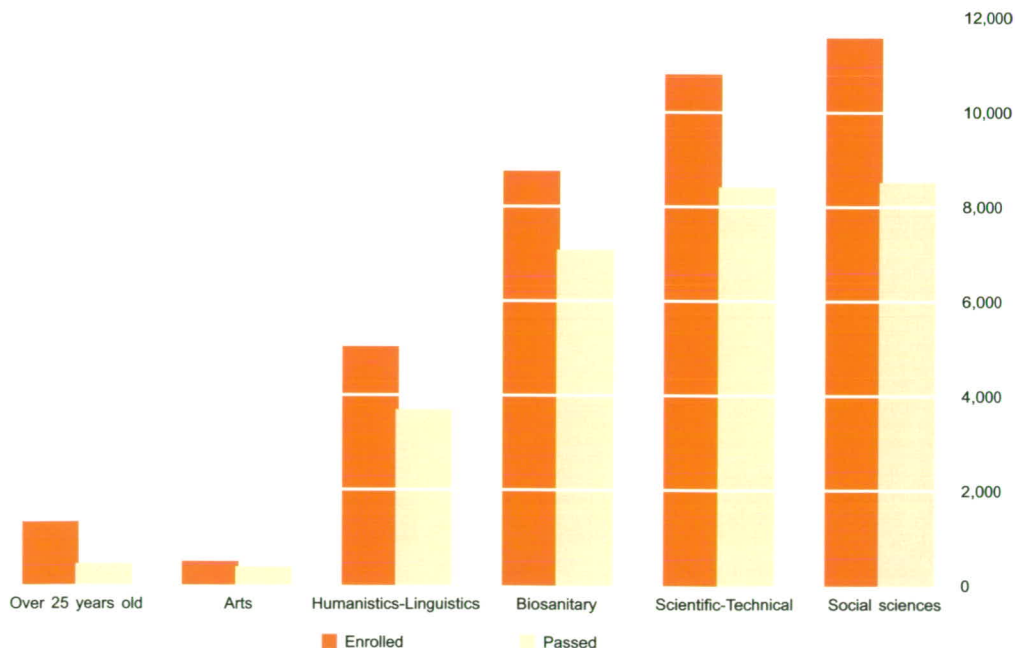

5.4. Breakdown of the students who had pass the University Entrance Exam. Enrolled and passed. 2001



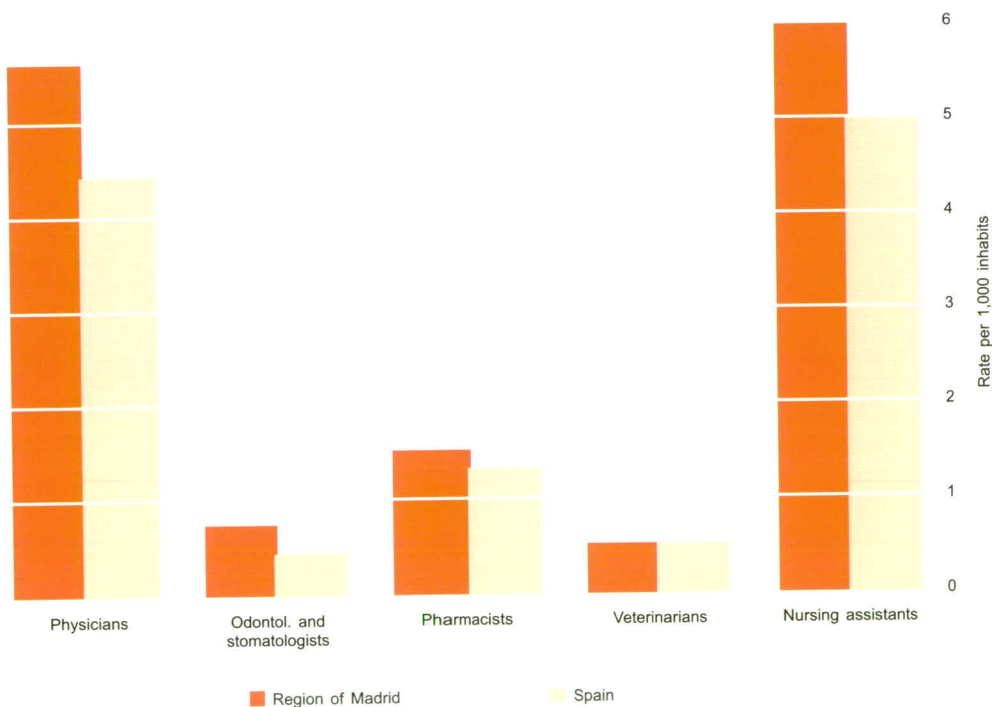

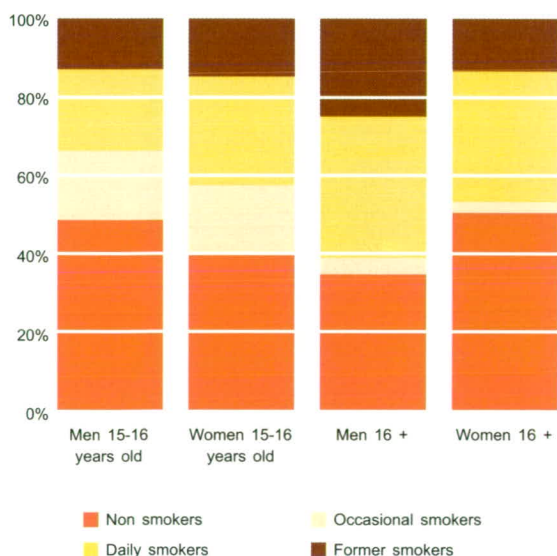

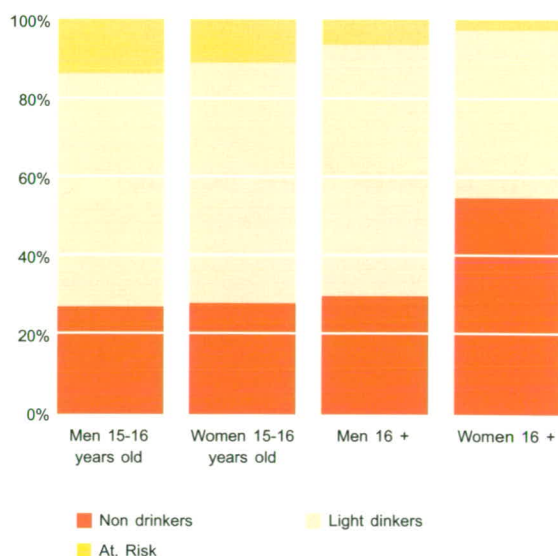

6.5. Breakdown of adult and teenage population by alcohol consumption. 2001



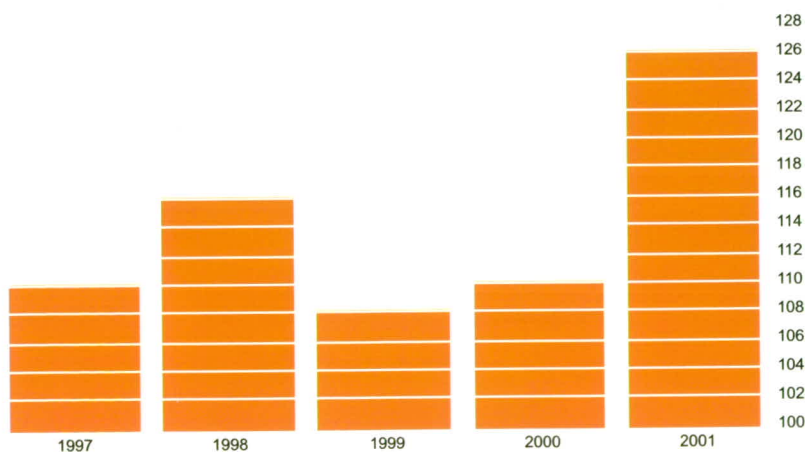

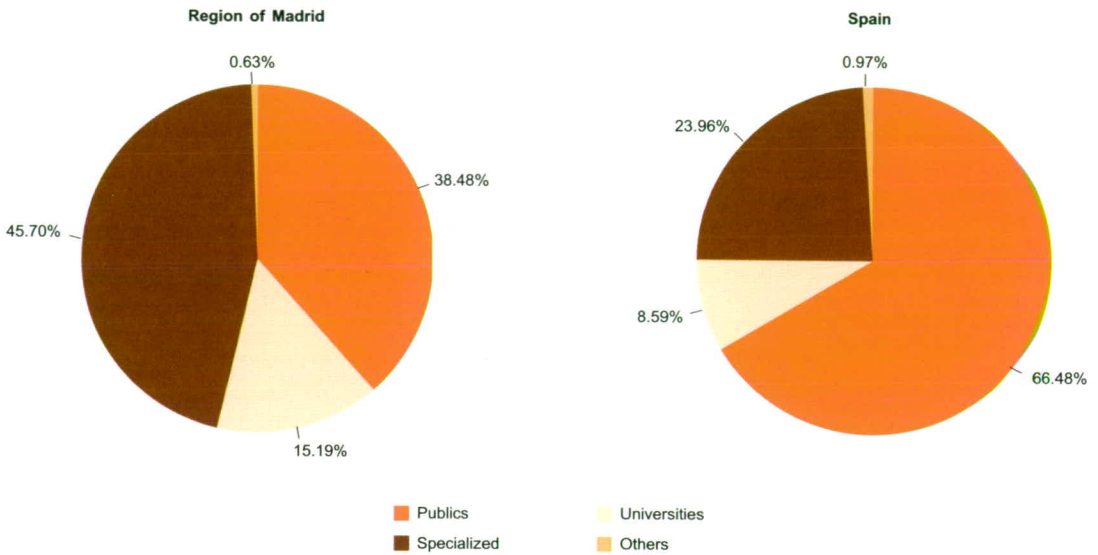

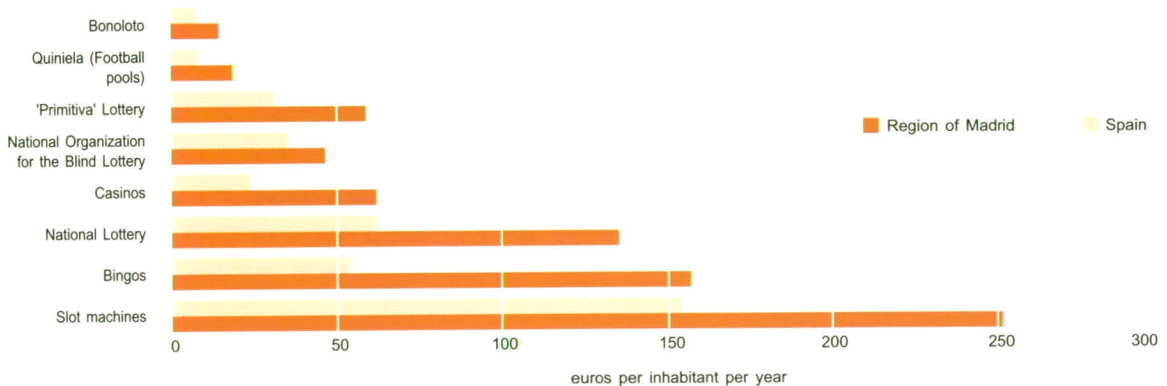

7.4. Annual per capita gambling expenditure. 2001



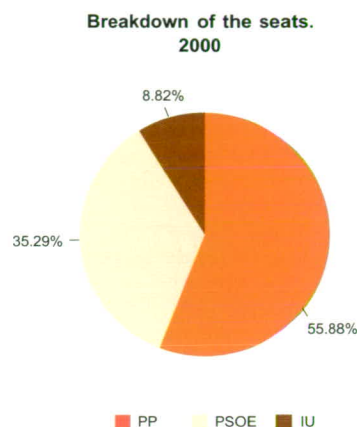

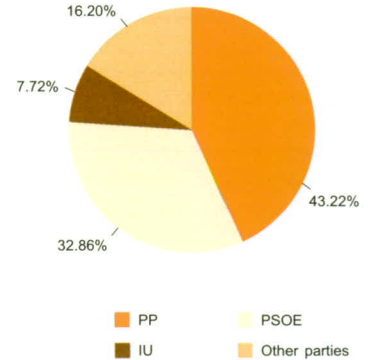

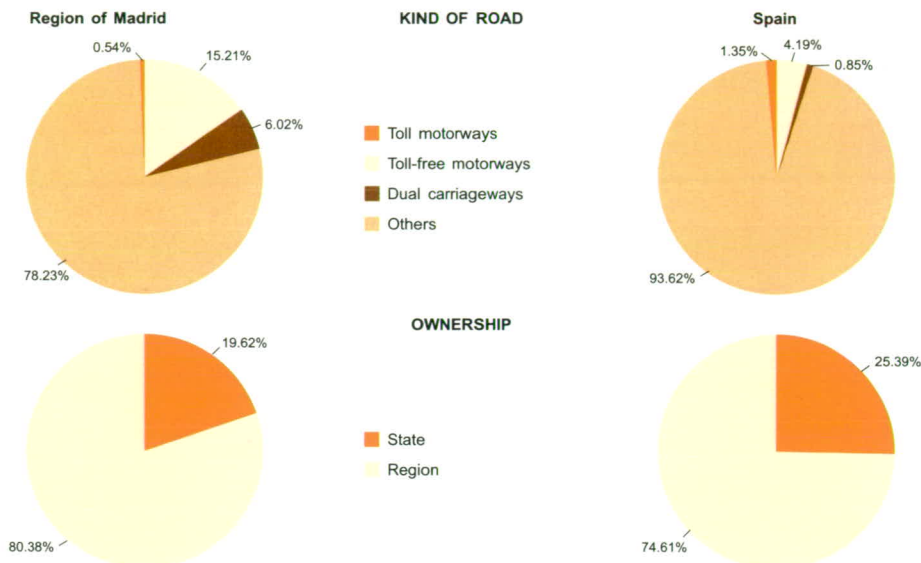

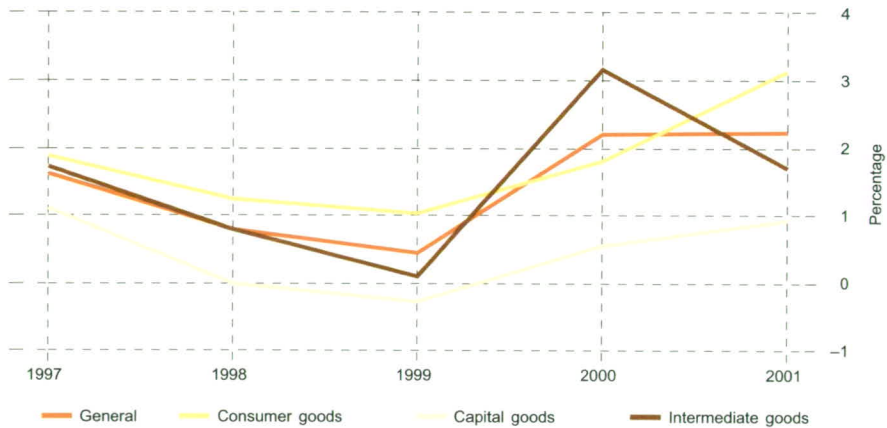

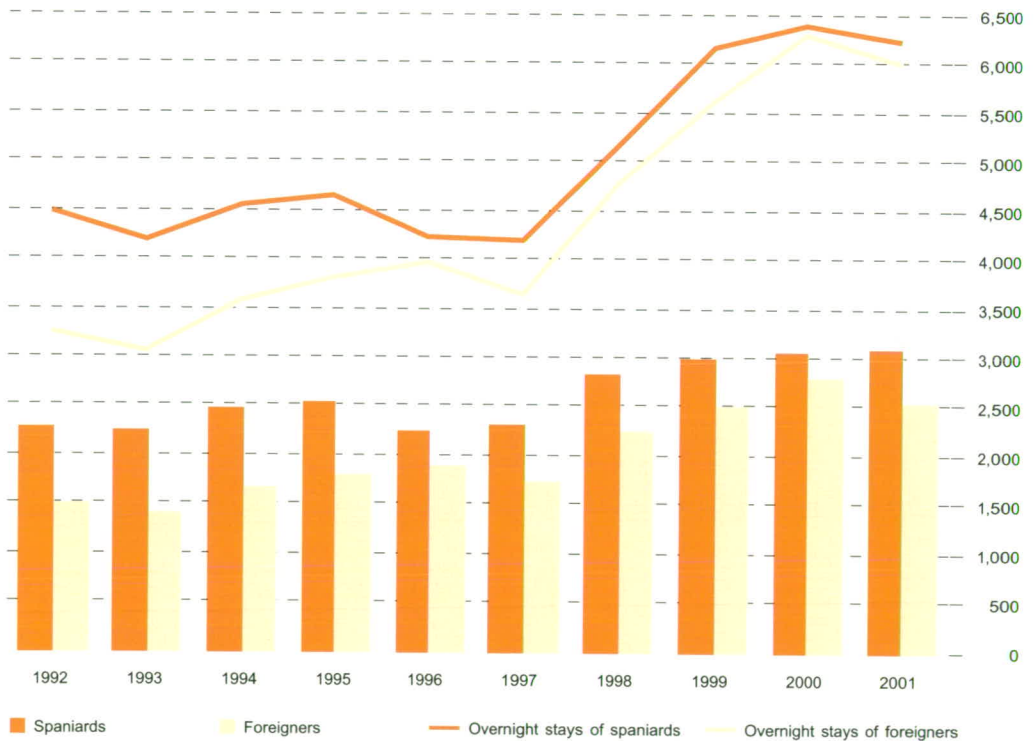

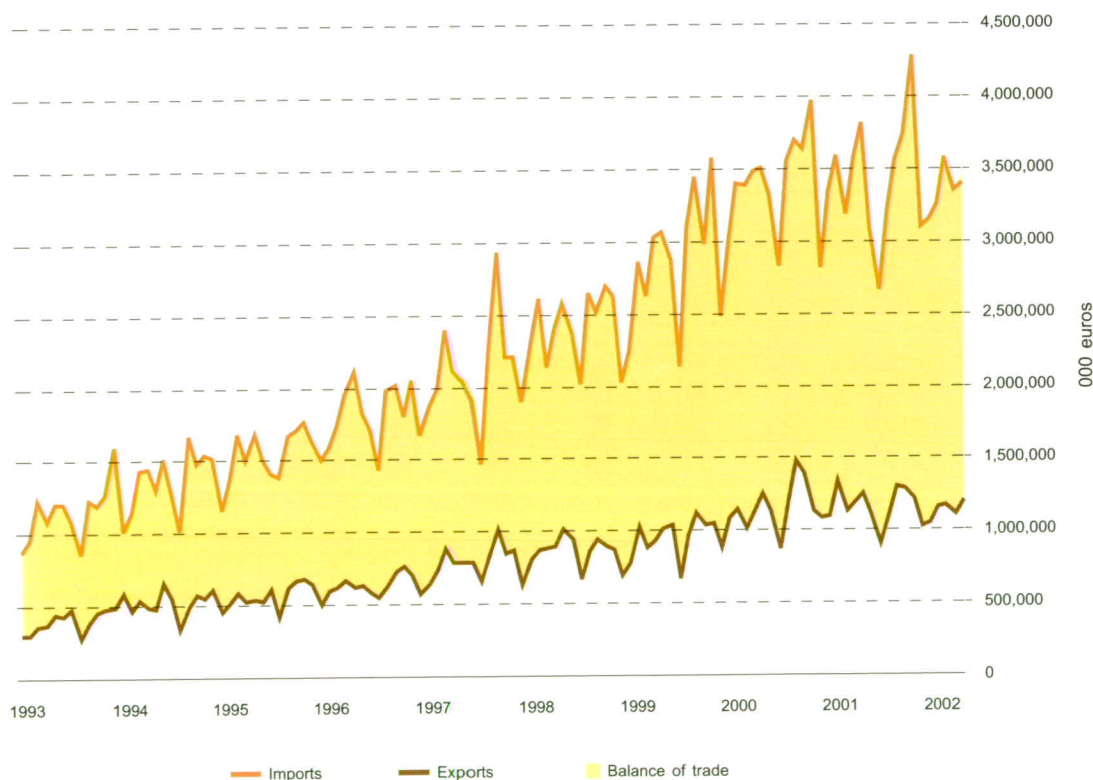

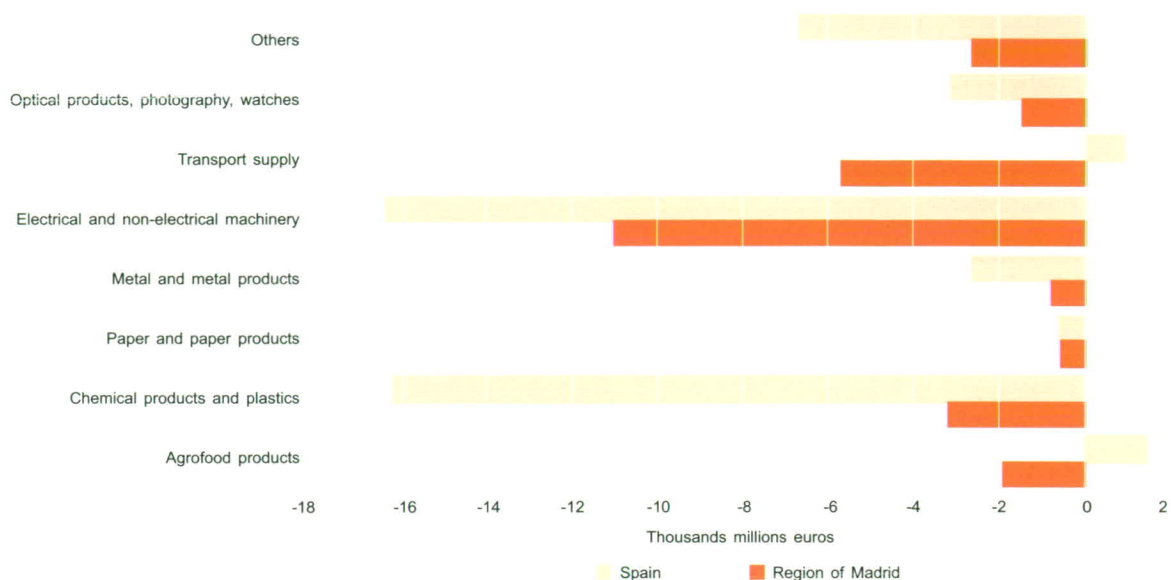

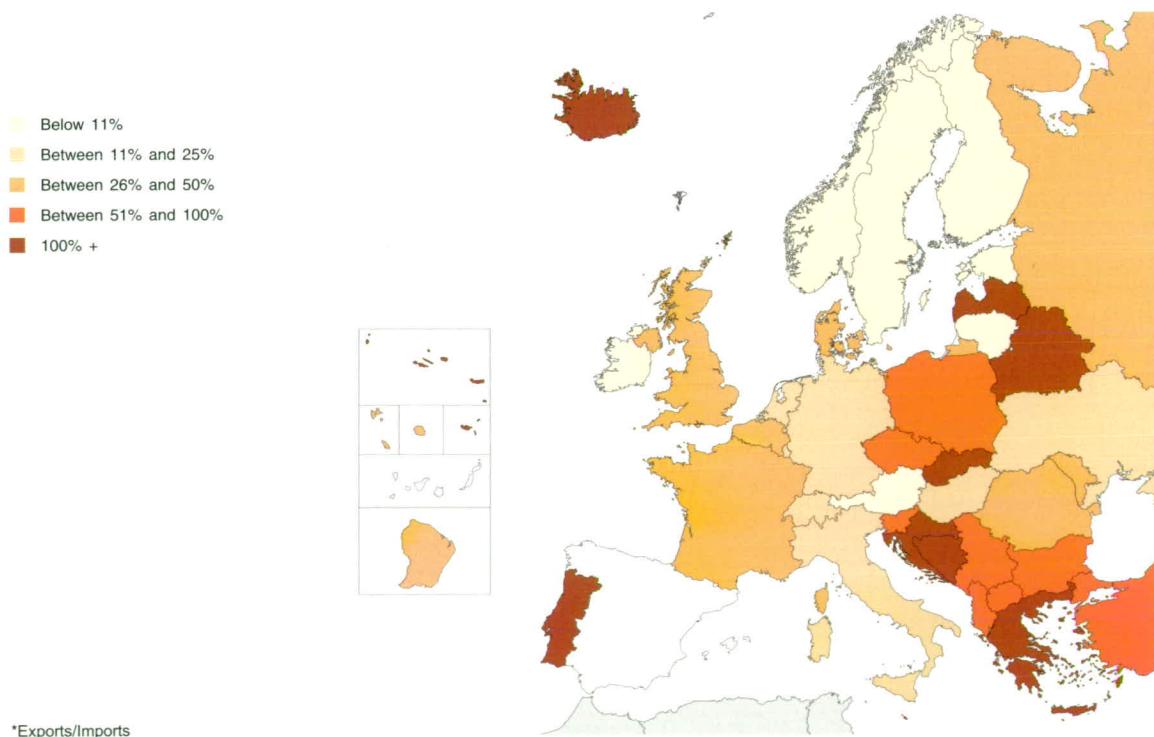


13.7. Balance of trade by products*. 2000

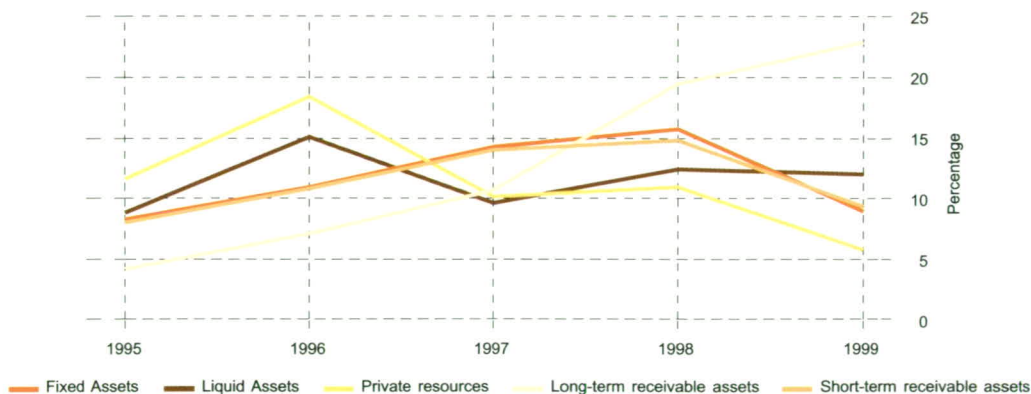

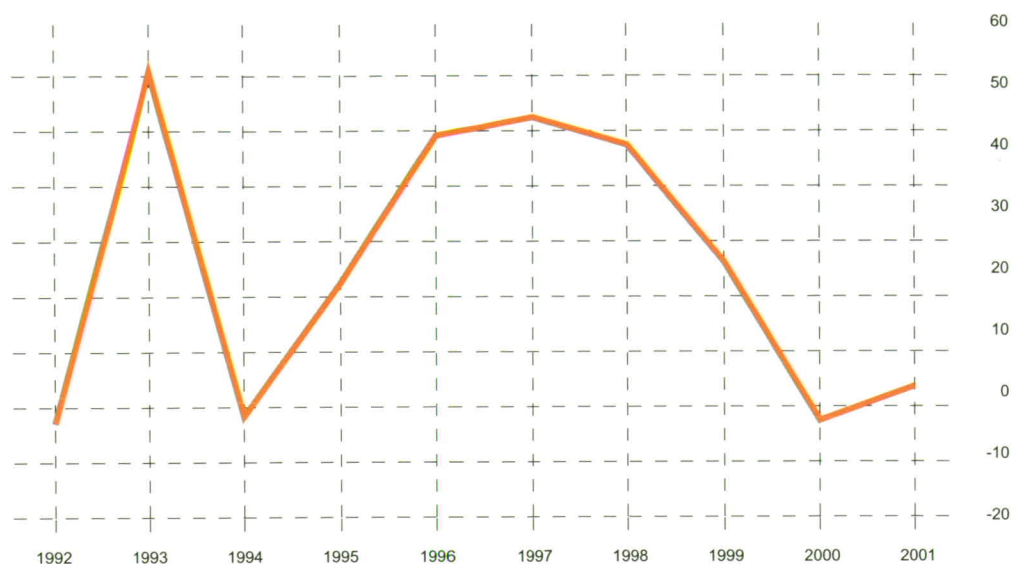

14.6. Year-to-year change in the Madrid Stock Exchange general index

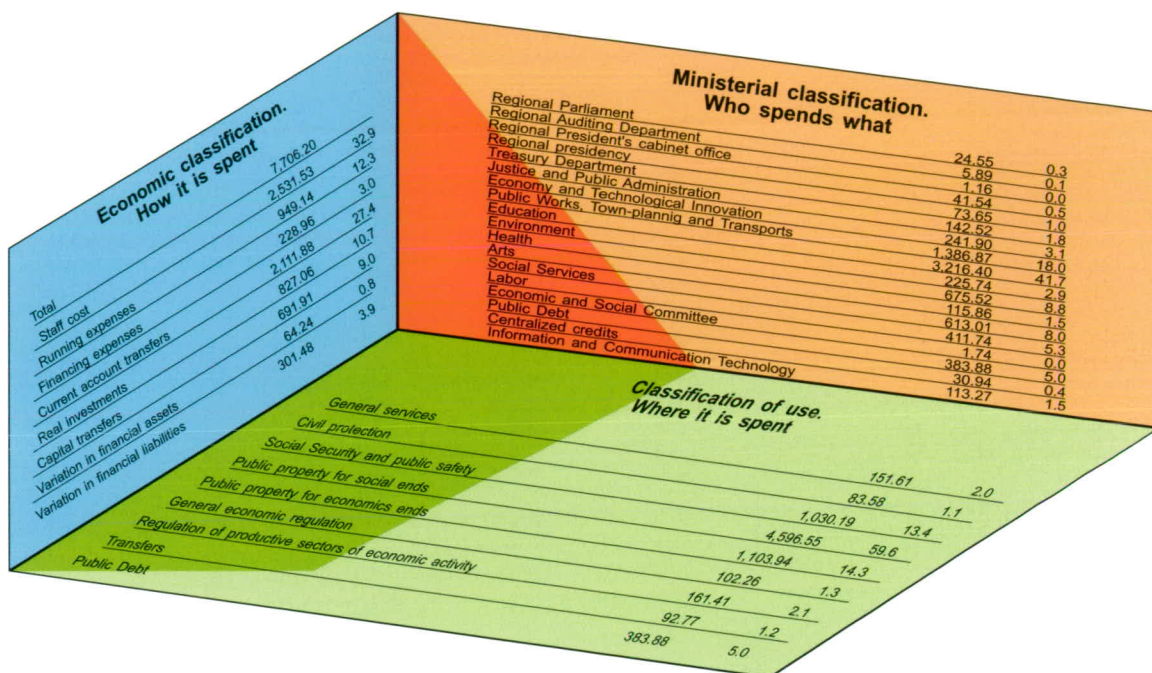

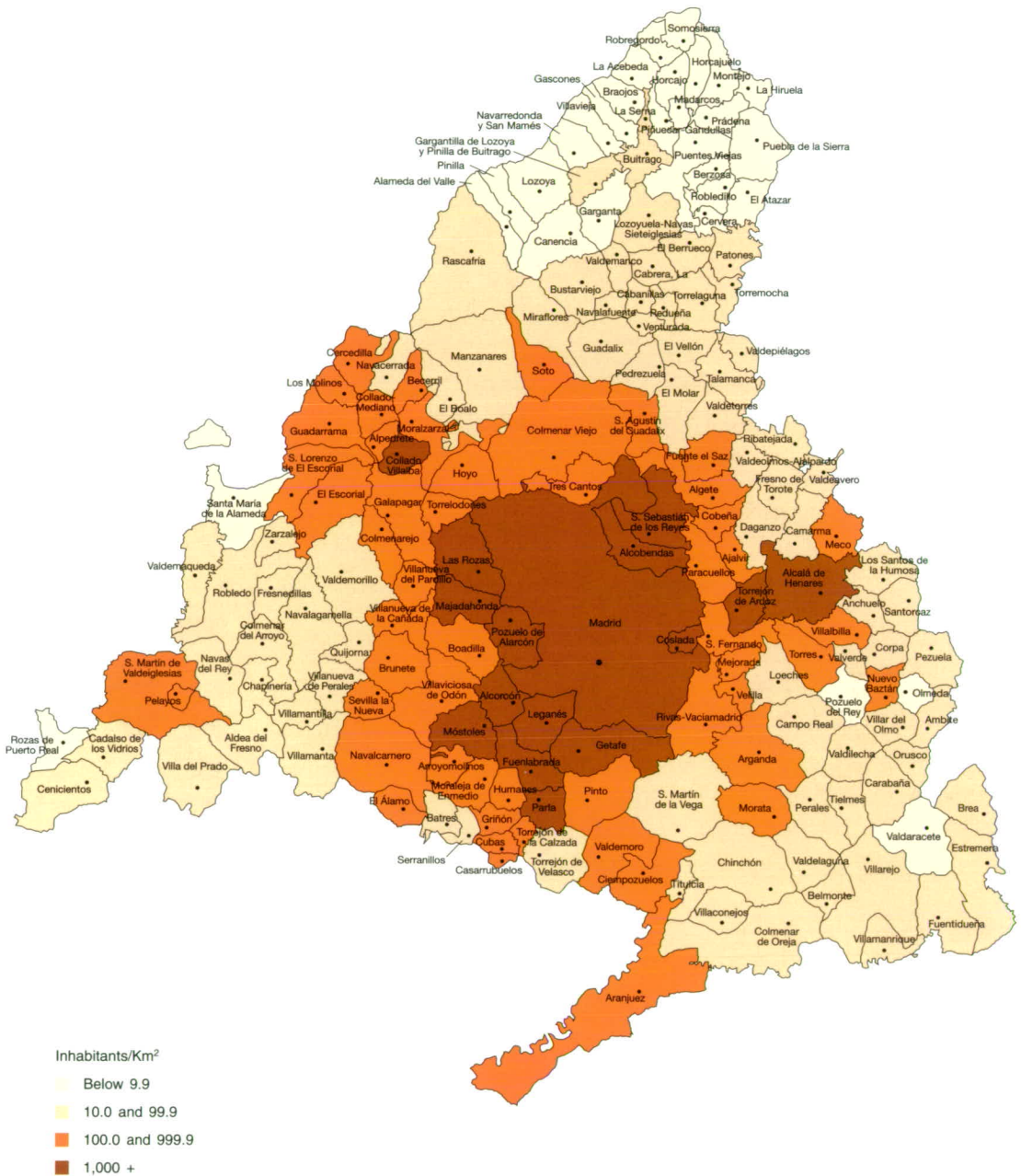

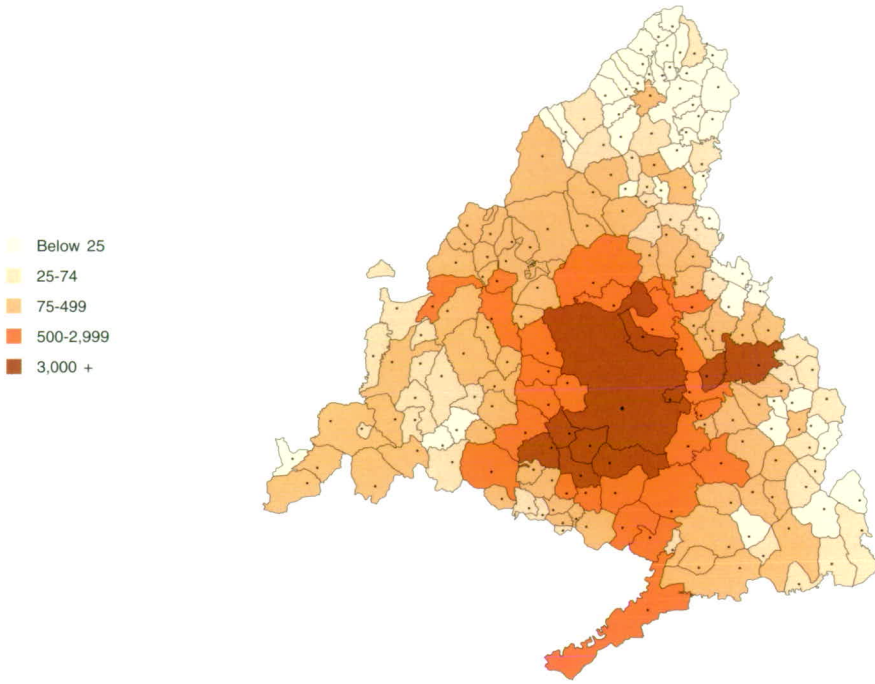
17.1. Population change (%). 2000-2001



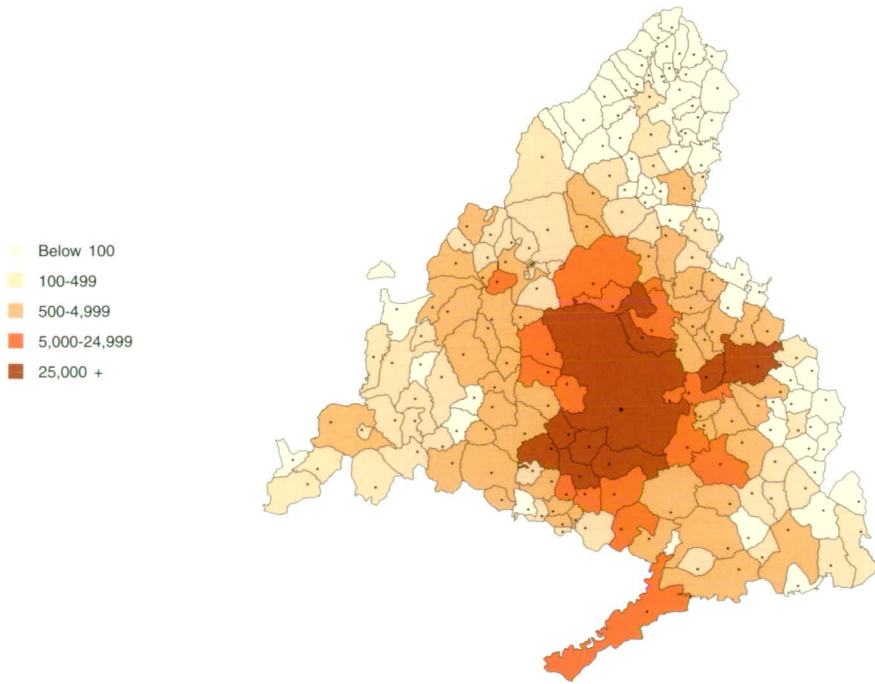
17.2. Population density. 2001



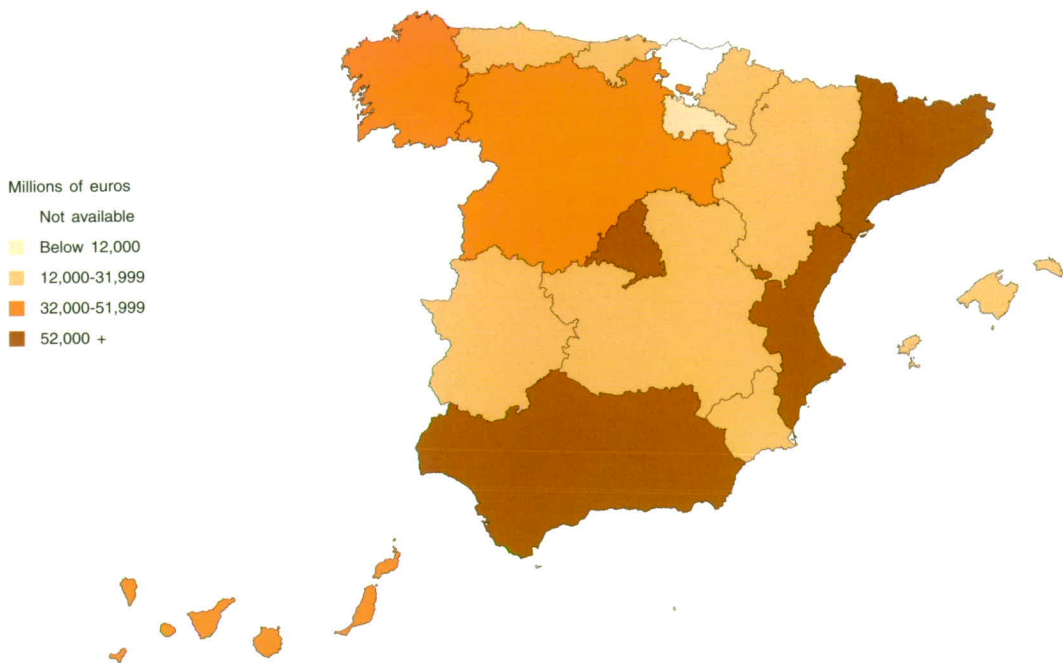
17.4. Economic activity units. 2001



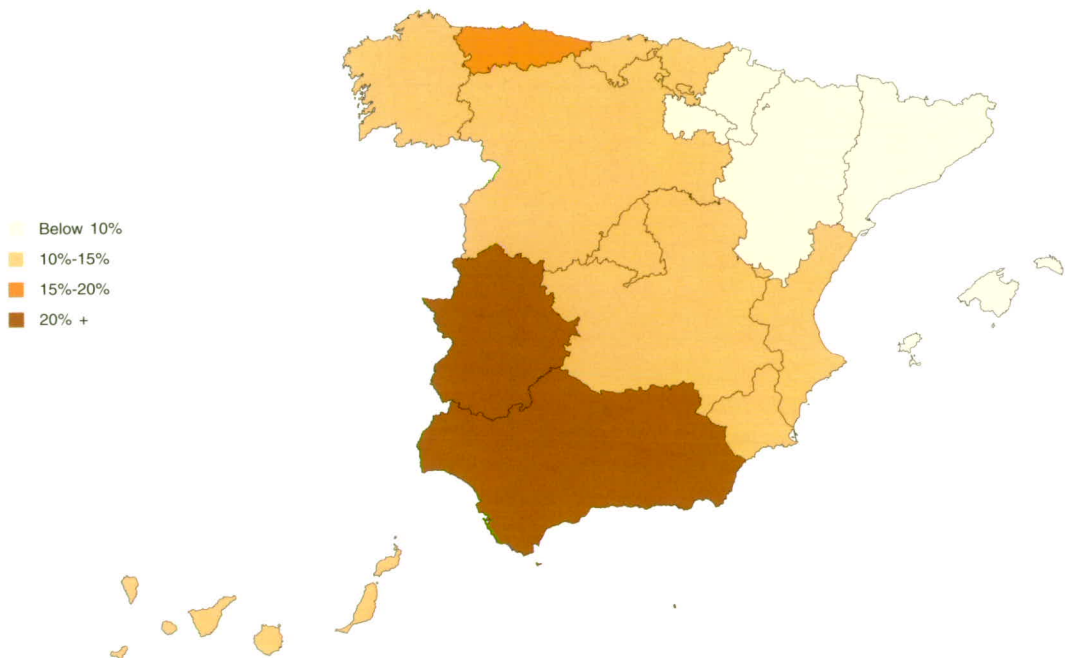
17.5. Employed in economic activity units. 2001



17.6. Urban Cadastral value. 2000

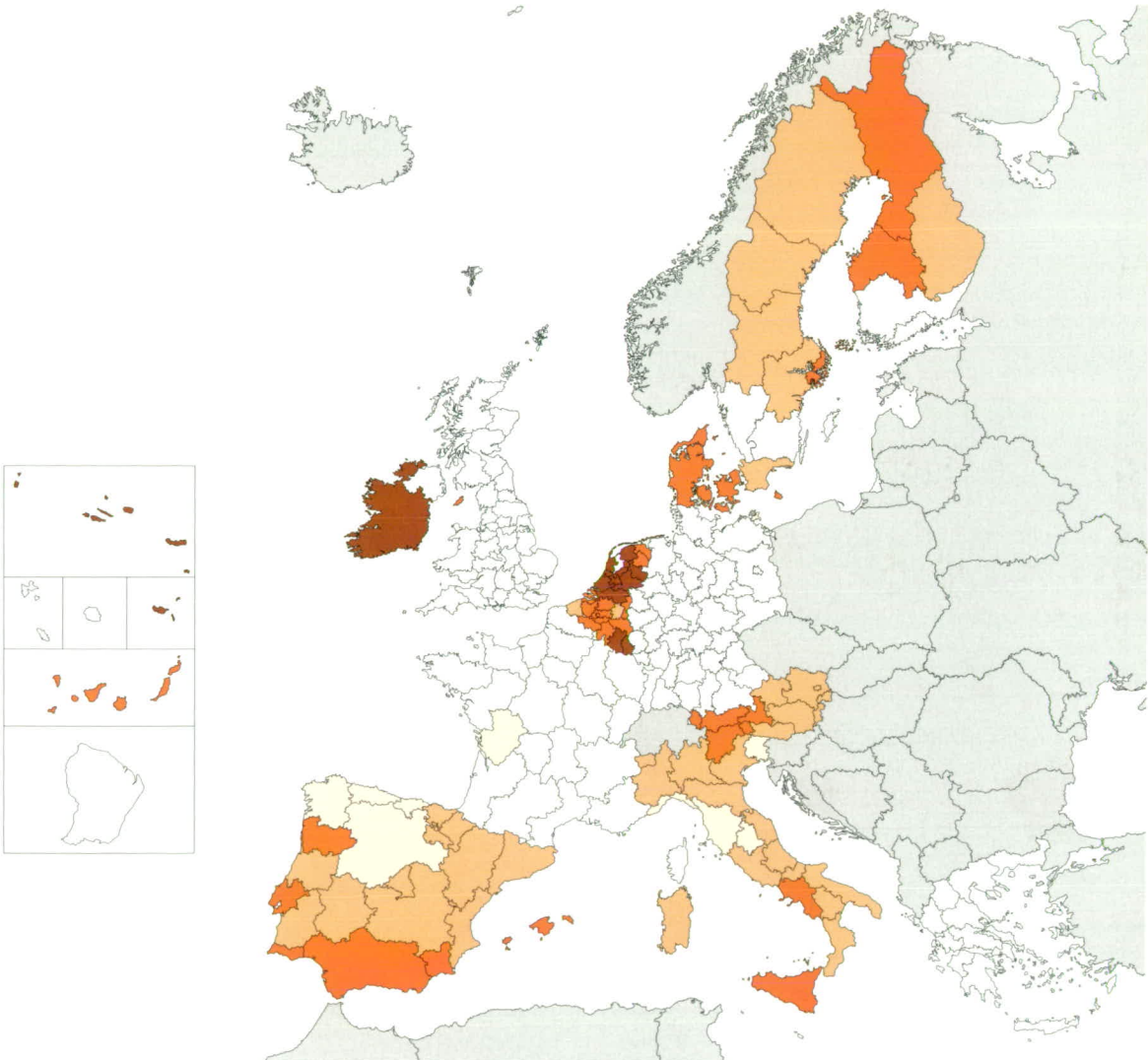


17.7. Unemployment rate. 2000



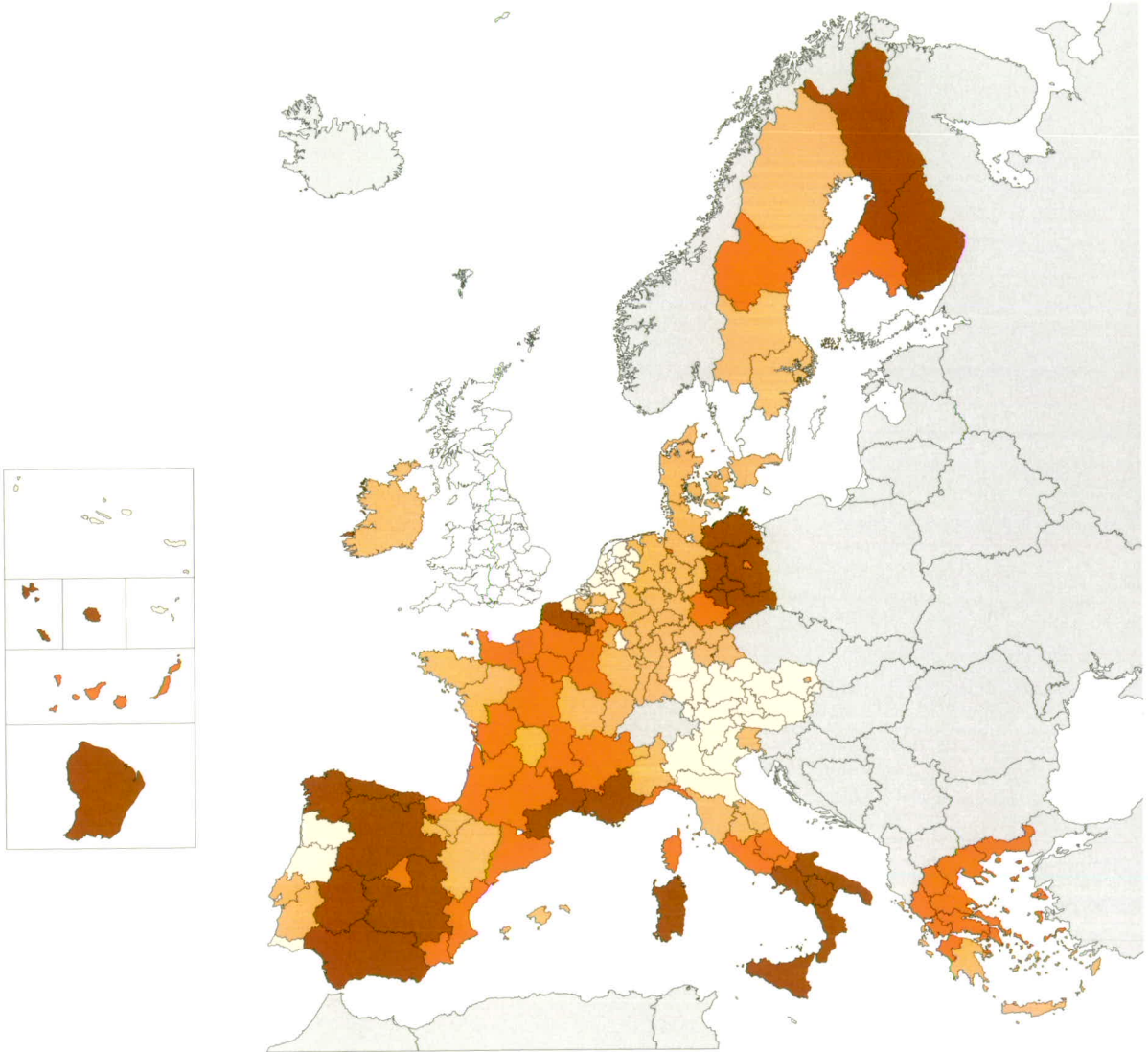
